The Cabin key will be given upon check-in at the Campground Office.

Check-in is 3 PM.

Check-out is 11 AM. Campground Season is April 15th through the last Sunday in September.

CAMPGROUND RULES (Detailed list available upon check-in and posted in Cabin)

- **Speed Limit is 5MPH throughout the Campground at ALL times.**
- **Quiet hours are 11PM-7AM, seven days a week.**
- **All pets MUST be on a leash. You are responsible for your pet and for sanitary disposal of pet waste. Pets are NOT allowed in Cabins or Houses.**
- **Minors MUST be supervised by someone 21 years of age or older while occupying the Campground.**
- **No drugs, drug paraphernalia, firearms, weapons, or illegal activities will be tolerated. ALL offenders will be prosecuted.**

CAMPGROUND ACTIVITIES

During your stay, take advantage of the Playground, Sand Volleyball Court, Private Beach, Walking/Bike trails, and of course the Lake.

Enjoy a soft serve Ice Cream Treat at the Office. They also offer Ice, COLD Beer/Beverages, Wine, Pizza, Hot Dog Specials, Candy, Pop, Apparel, as well as a few basic Grocery Items.

FISHING

Lost Island Lake offers walleye, bullhead, crappie, bluegill, northern pike, catfish and yellow perch. Boating is allowed on the Lake with no size limit on boat motors. Public boat ramps have a hard surface for ease in launching and docking of boats. – Please let Office know if you have brought a boat with you so that you may be instructed as to parking of the boat/trailer.

CHECK-OUT PROCEDURE

As a reminder, Check-out is 11 AM on the day that your booking ends.

*****BEFORE you leave, PLEASE:**

- Put all the dishtowels and other items needing washed in the bin provided.
- Collect ALL garbage and put it in the dumpster located next to the bathrooms.
- Wash ALL dishes and return them to where they were found.
- Turn ALL lights and air conditioning off.
- Close ALL windows.
- Turn the water heater switch off. Located under the sink.
- Turn off the water faucet located behind the cabin.
- Make sure the gas tank on the grill is off.
- **Please return the Cabin Key to the Office.**
- **LEAVE THE CABIN and GROUND CLEAN and TIDY.**
Failure to do so could result in future bookings being denied. However, we understand accidents happen and things break so please bring those things to our attention so we can address them as soon as possible.
